Dear Twin Lakes Golfer;

We are pleased to enclose with this letter the 2011 season renewal data sheet. On behalf of all the staff at Twin Lakes, we thank you for your support during the 2010 year.

We will be continuing our efforts to improve the condition of the golf course, its playability and the appearance for both members and guests to enjoy in the coming year.

For 2011 we have created two new golf programs for “new” golfers and other players with the hope that it will entice more golfers to come to Twin Lakes to experience the game we all love and enjoy. The first program, “The Learn to Play” program will have restricted playing times, but will include golf, rental clubs and access to the cart program. (Limited numbers will be sold so not to impact regular play)

The second program, “The Player’s Card” is designed for golfers who want to play Twin Lakes but not at a full membership level. The Player’s Card is a reasonably priced and flexible option to a full play membership. Twin Lakes Golf will be the only course offering these two flexible programs.

Please note the following for the 2011 membership renewal.

- Players Card (new for 2011); this may even work for you!
- Learn to Play (introduction to golf at Twin Lakes Golf Course)
- Opening day will be May 1st. Weather and course conditions permitting; the golf course will open earlier. Closing day will be October 31st, with possible limited days of play after October 16, 2011 based on weather conditions.
- The 7 day advance tee time booking for members will be in effect for 2011. Booking can be done in person, by phone or using the web site under “book a tee time”.
- The booking fee has been removed and will not be in effect for 2011.



- The two year subsidized cart rental program has now been adjusted to market pricing for similar programs in the area. Member's paying guest, still ride for free if you are participating in the 2011 **Gold** or **Silver** membership program.
- Shotgun starts for Tuesday Senior's Day will be reintroduced during the opening and closing shoulder seasons. A policy will be developed once the new clubhouse manager has been hired and this will be distributed accordingly.
- A student rate for ages 16-21 at \$240.00 will remain unchanged from last year. The junior category for ages 12 to 15 will continue to be without charge and membership will be by application and management approval. The number of participants will be limited and we will review a restriction of playing times and strict rules for these juniors to follow. If you know a junior who could benefit from this program, please contact the pro shop to put forth a recommendation.
- During the year the course will be closed for seasonal maintenance days, specifically spring and fall aeration. Membership will be advised in advance of these dates and other required dates. The goal will be to perform this requirement to avoid as much disruption to play as possible.
- Medical refunds will be available before May 1st. A Doctors certificate is required.
- If you make your payment for annual renewal on or before March 5, 2011 a 7% early pay discount will apply to membership fees.

Staff and management will continue to work hard to provide the best overall golfing experience for its members and guests. We continue to be very proud of the golf community at Twin Lakes Golf Course, the uniqueness of the properties location and the surrounding natural environment.

Thank you for being a repeat members and supporter of Twin Lakes Golf Course and we look forward to seeing you and your friends playing golf at the course.
